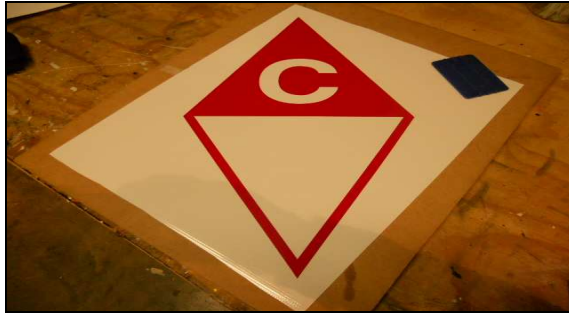


The following are the various steps we go through to produce high quality, long lasting, boat size specific sail cover logos at [www.sailboatlogos.com](http://www.sailboatlogos.com).

1. The vinyl logo is first applied to a heavy duty, outdoor grade, white banner material.



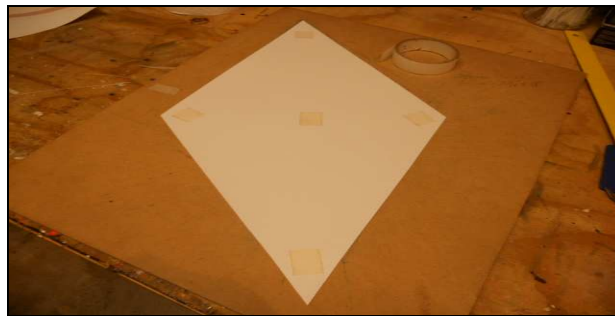
2. Next, the trimming process begins, leaving approx ½" border around the vinyl logo for stitching.



3. Trim work is completed



4. On the reverse side, double stick banner hem tape is applied at various points. This assists the end user in positioning the logo on the sail cover and temporarily holds the logo in place while stitching is applied.



5. It is time to apply the boat size numbers – in this case – black vinyl numerals for a Catalina 42



6. Numerals 42 applied and register center line is removed. Logo is cleaned & inspected at both front and back sides at this point. The original Order is rechecked to assure no detail is missed.



7. One set (2 pieces) Item #1005 for a Catalina 42 with application instruction sheet ready for shipment.



8. Logos are rolled up and inserted into a thick walled tube in order to prevent creasing during shipment.
